RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. All contestants must wear a Coast Guard approved vest or life preserver while the gasoline motor is running.
- 2. Fishing is permitted any place on the tournament lake or on connecting waters that can be reached by boat.
- 3. All state and local laws must be observed.
- 4. Any contestant with a written violation during the tournament hours will be disqualified.
- NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES will be allowed in boats or at the tournament site.
- 6. No more than 2 contestants per boat.
- 7. All fishing must be done from the boat.
- 8. Only artificial lures will be permitted. No fly rods or cane poles are allowed.
- 9. The tournament will begin at 7:30am SHARP and will conclude at 3:30pm. NO GRACE TIME will be allowed. Check in after 3:30pm will result in disqualification.
- 10. All boats must be 14ft. in length or over. Canoes will not be permitted.
- 11. All boats will be assigned an ooze off number according to the postmarked entry dates.
- 12. All bass must be 12 inches minimum length measured with closed mouth to tip of tail No striped bass or white bass allowed.
- 13. Only 5 bass per boat may be weighed in. There will be a 4-ounce deduction for each dead fish.
- 14. All bass will be returned to Indian Lake if found to be in good shape and expected to live. Consideration will be given to a request to keep a fish for mounting. This is a definite rule.
- 15. Big Bas must be alive when weighed in.
- 16. Tournament fisherman may leave the boat in case of emergency without being disqualified from the tournament.
- 17. Winners will be determined by total weight minus any deductions.
- 18. Tie breakers: 1st largest number of live fish; 2nd total number of fish. In case of further ties the prize money will be split between the tying teams or a coin flip if tying teams agree.
- 19. The decisions of the tournament committee are final.
